

## **BUILDING COMMITTEE**

The goal of the Building Committee is to handle routine maintenance in the church throughout the calendar year, minor repairs on plumbing, furniture, etc; any painting improvements needed, and arranging for contractors for specialized jobs through proper channels. Normal Work Day tasks were accomplished by individual effort this year. Thank you each and all! We hope to revert to more involvement with our expert congregational volunteers in future Work Days. Some of the tasks completed since last year's report were repairing of the roof over the chapel area, a new thermostat in the sanctuary, one in Reeve Hall, and one in the Chapel. We tackled mice, ants, squirrels and termites this year. Metuchen YMCA's Camp Lenape provided for their usual carpet shampooing and stripping and waxing of the Fellowship Hall floor. The chapel and music room floors were stripped and waxed by our sexton. The black mold was removed from the outside of the church building as part of the new Capital Campaign projects. When Hurricane Sandy hit in the end of 2012 we were pleased to provide a home, and central station site for the North Carolina Baptist Men's Disaster Recovery Team while they were taking care of the business of helping storm victims in our area and South Jersey. Expert volunteer electrical skill kept the building lighted inside and out.
